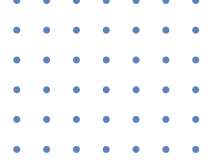

developing group consultancy practice

June 21st and 28th 2020

We are delighted to offer 2 day live **online workshop** for group facilitators and consultants who are committed to developing their practice.

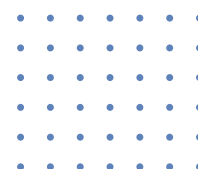
The workshop combines **theory** and **practice** and is centred around four key themes:

- *How to make sense of the complex dynamics in workplace teams?*
- *How to develop a containing presence in the consultant's role?*
- *How to develop a stance that fosters creative change?*
- *The personal learning and change required for developing practice*

The workshop is based on **Tavistock group relations methodology** which, in turn, draws on **systems psychodynamic theory**. The programme is designed to meet the needs of group facilitators and consultants who are interested in developing their skills as well as offering personal development and an introduction to new perspectives. No special prior experience is required. The format will introduce theory and make use of experiential exercises, consultancy practice and take-away tasks. The workshop readings will be sent out in advance for those who booked the place.

The attendance at both days is required.

The workshop is led by **Jo-anne Carlyle** and **Chris Tanner**, United Kingdom. On the staff team are **Jolita Buzaitytė-Kašalynienė** and **Erika Speičytė-Ruschhoff**, Lithuania.





Jo-anne Carlyle PhD is a clinical and forensic psychologist, a psychoanalytic psychotherapist and organisational consultant and brings group, clinical and research experience from a range of settings including the Tavistock Clinic. She is Programme Lead for the joint British Psychotherapy Foundation/ University of Exeter MSc in Psychological Therapies; Psychoanalytic stream. She has consulted in the UK, India, Lithuania and Ecuador.

Jolita Buzaitytė-Kašalynienė PhD is associate professor at Vilnius University, Institute of Sociology and Social Work with a multidisciplinary educational background and research interests. Since 2010 she has organised and directed international group relations conferences in Vilnius. She was also a staff member on group relations conferences in Leicester, Italy, Cyprus (PCCA) and Russia. She is co-founder and president of Lithuanian Group Relations Society.

Chris Tanner MA is a coach and organisational consultant with wide experience of working with teams in the health, social care and education sector. He is course director of the MA Management and Organisational Dynamics, at University of Essex and is a senior lecturer with the NHS Leadership Academy, UK. He is the training director for OPUS (Organization For Promotion Of Understanding In Society), the Society for Organizational Consultants in the UK.

Erika Speičytė-Ruschhoff MA is an organisational consultant with expertise in education science, social work & social pedagogy. She worked with many NGO-based and public sector institutions of social care and adult education both in Germany and Lithuania. She has been a staff member and consultant on the international Vilnius group relations conferences since 2014 and is co-founder & board member of Lithuanian Group Relations Society. Currently she is a PhD candidate on doctoral programme at the Tavistock Clinic & Essex university, UK.
